

POLICE & CHILD ABUSE REGISTRY CHECKS


The Official Board has decided that we should require police and child abuse registry checks for staff and Sunday school teachers.

Also, criminal reference checks will be required for **volunteers** who are visiting on behalf of the Pastoral Care committee with individuals in nursing homes, etc.

Trinity will pay for the fees involved for current staff and volunteers.

While we believe that all our staff and volunteers are honourable people, these checks offer one more assurance that Trinity folk are safe in their company.

These checks are commonly done by other organizations in our community as well.

United Church of Canada Guidelines

As an employee of the United Church of Canada (not Trinity United Church) Reverend Doug is entitled to and required to take the following.

- --No less than three weeks of Study Leave per year (including Sundays) for continuing education that directly benefits the work of the church or the needs of the congregation.
- --A minimum of one month vacation (including 5 Sundays) within each pastoral year. The church year runs from July 1 to June 30^{th} .
