There is a box in the narthex from the Lions Club to receive any old glasses. Thanks to those who have done so!! Keep them coming!!

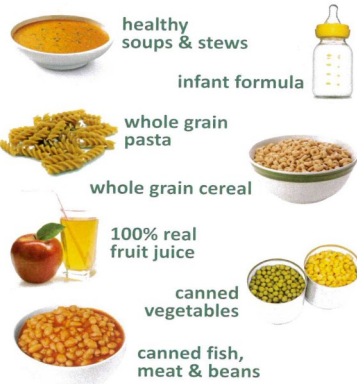

A crow was sitting on a tree, doing nothing all day.

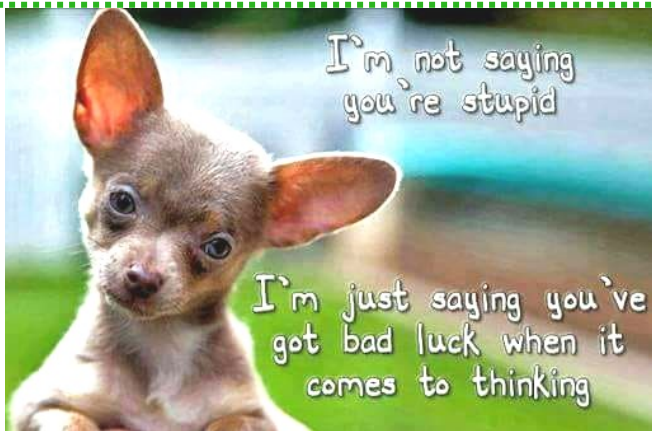
A rabbit asked him,

Moral of the story: To be sitting and doing nothing, you must be sitting very high up.

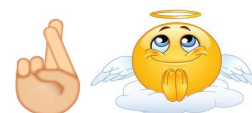


Our 'Ailing' & Aging Elevator
